Misc.: Jed brings up charging according to meters with Rocky Mountain Power. Mayfield city

called they are being charged for 7 meters, and Gunnison is being charged for 37 meters. Would like to approach the district to maybe redo some of these, a lot don't need to be charged a fire fee. Maybe give the fire chiefs the ability to go and evaluate the meters and bring them to the district. Another idea would be to maybe charge each city one meter no matter how many they have. Jeff thinks maybe leave it up to the fire chief, just give them direction. Thinks if it is on a structure it should be charged. Elliot agrees the chief should, it's a great way to do it. Zack thinks that as well, and then they can bring it to the district. From a report Mark looked at it looked like Gunnison high school had at least four different meters. Rocky Mountain Power has agreed to do a monthly report and send that to us, so we can dispute or talk about it. Think at this point, leave it to the chiefs and come to the district with it, will need to add this to the policies, and get to work on that. Vote on policy for meter exemptions for next month, Jeff will write one up to bring. Something brief should work just fine. If you start hearing of any complaints, take them and bring them to the meetings as they come up. Hopefully Mark should have that report next month. Truck committee will have some stuff put together for next month, to get started on some new projects. Add truck committee to next meeting agenda. Elliot would also like to thank everyone, and especially station 8 for all the help they gave Elliot, and all those who came and helped with the funeral last month, it was really nice.
