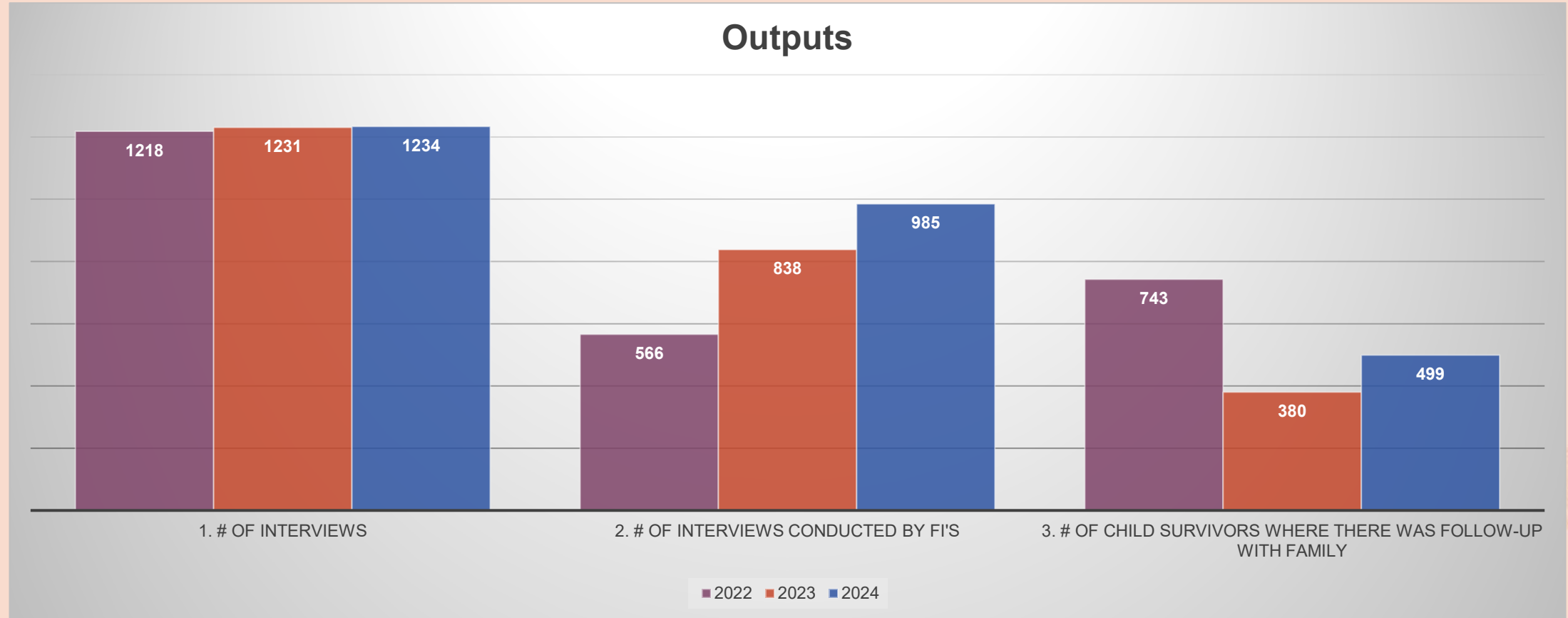

- **277** on-site medical exams



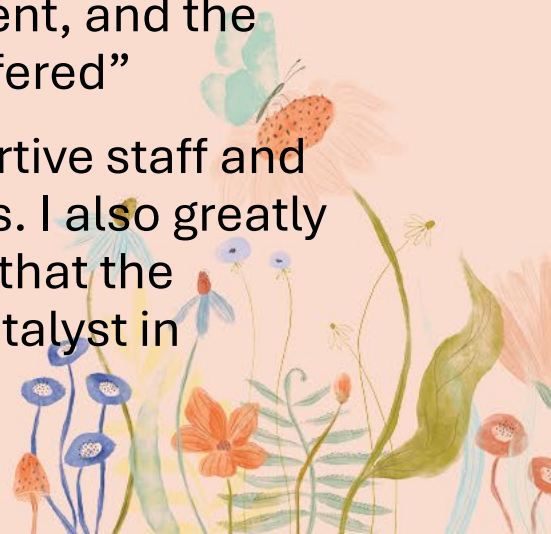
Outcome Measurement System Survey Results

- **Parent satisfaction surveys:**

- *% Strongly Agree; The Center staff made sure I understood the reason for our visit to the center. **89.2%***
- *% Strongly Agree; My child and I were greeted and received attention in a timely manner. **95.1%***
- *%; Strongly Agree; I was given information about the services and programs provided by the center. **97.7%***
- *% Strongly Agree; My questions were answered to my satisfaction. **95%***
- *% Strongly Agree; The process for interviewing my child was clearly explained to me. **95.1%***
- *% Strongly Agree; The staff was friendly and pleasant. **94.7%***
- *% Strongly Agree; The staff provided me with resources to support my child and respond to his or her needs in the days and weeks ahead. **92.7%***

- **Caregiver Comments/Feedback:**

- “To help me to process the situation, and to understand my daughter what she’s going through to be there for her.”
- “The environment is welcoming and so child friendly, we felt more at ease as soon as we walked in the door. The staff are also very child focused and calm.”
- “I appreciate the gentle, hopeful nature of the staff, the calm environment, and the knowledgeable resources offered”
- “I truly appreciate the supportive staff and the connections to resources. I also greatly appreciated the perspective that the interview can be a healing catalyst in trauma recovery.”
