



COTTONWOOD HEIGHTS NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Pursuant to UCA 10-9a-609.5, notice is hereby given that the Cottonwood Heights City Council will hold a public hearing on **October 28, 2014**, to receive input on the proposed vacation of a right-of-way or easement.

The proposed vacation concerns a portion (the “Segment”) of the “Interconnect Trail System” (the “Trail”) that abuts the rear (Northerly) lot lines of Lots 607 – 620 of the Mill Hollow Estates Plat “F” Subdivision. The Segment was included within the fenced back yards (“Yards”) of those lots in approximately 1993, reportedly with the express consent of Salt Lake County (Cottonwood Heights’ predecessor-in-interest). The Segment has remained part of the fenced Yards since that time; the Trail has never been used for any public purpose; and a substitute public trail is located approximately 22 feet to the North of the Trail.

The hearing will be held at the Cottonwood Heights city offices, 1265 East Fort Union Blvd., Suite 300, at 7:00 p.m. or as soon thereafter as the matter can be heard. Inquiries should be directed to City Manager, John Park, at 801-944-7010 or jpark@ch.utah.gov.

The proposal is available for public inspection and may be examined during regular business hours at the office of the City Recorder, 1265 East Fort Union Blvd., Suite 250, Cottonwood Heights, UT 84047.
