Distribution of December 4, 2024, Minutes

The minutes for the Council Workshop Meeting held on December 4, 2024, were distributed prior to the meeting.

<u>Division Updates</u>

Patrick Craig reviewed the Division Update sheet that was provided as part of the meeting package. Homeless Camp Cleanup: The County Council approved the 2025 request for 1,500 tons. Chris Bell adds a week before Christmas, the State Legislature and Governor Cox came to Mayor Mendenhall and City Administration with a request to address public safety concerns and homeless related issues, and this may possibly increase the volume of homeless camp cleanup material. Patrick Craig participated in a meeting with the Illegal Dumping committee last week to address some tires that have been dumped around the county. One specific location was at Lee Kay Ponds and 21st South. At this area there has been a little over 6,000 tires dumped. Hayley Shaffer added they have arrested several people associated with this dumping in the county.

Financial Report

Patrick Craig reviewed 2024 Financial Report of Expense and Revenues, MSW Report, Green Waste Report, and Top MSW Customers that are provided as part of the meeting package. Other Green Waste will not be tracked in 2025 as it will be tracked as part of the

MSW waste. We will continue to track curbside collected green waste that is used in the compost process. Cash balances will be reviewed and discussed soon, but final accounting for 2024 needs to be completed to allow us to do this accurately.





LANDFILL REVENUE RECEIVED VS EXPEC...




MSW Tons (K) - YTD January 2025


