Bid documents and specifications will be posted to the Utah Public Procurement Place (U3P), PURCHASING.UTAH.GOV (Bonfire) on or before **5:00 PM Wednesday, February 26th, 2025**. A 5% Bid Bond will be required.

The Engineering Division will receive electronic responses on PURCHASING.UTAH.GOV until **2:00 PM Tuesday, March 25th, 2025**. Responses received after this time will not be accepted.

Responses will be opened by Draper City staff and will be promptly posted to the Utah Public Procurement Place (U3P) website within 24 hours of the above-stated time and date, with only the names of the firms submitting responses and their total bid amounts being presented.

Preliminary bid results will be delivered to bidding contractors and available via email to those who submit a request to reed.reimschuessel@draperutah.gov.

Questions concerning the scope of work, response submittal, or process should be directed to us electronically through U3P before **5:00 PM Monday, March 24th, 2025**.

The City is not responsible for expenses incurred prior to award by the City Council. Draper City reserves the right to reject any and all responses and to waive any irregularities, informalities, or technicalities deemed in the best interest of the City.
