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SECTION 6 – Reports and Recommendations

All Reports and Recommendations, ~~made by the Chair,~~ from the CRB pertaining to use of force, statistics, and annual and quarterly reports will be ~~voted on and~~ approved by the CRB, before being presented ~~by the Chair~~ to the City Council, Mayor, Chief of Police, ~~the public,~~ or posted on the website. Reports will be ~~voted on approved~~ and presented within a reasonable time after the end of the quarterly or yearly timeframe.

Quarterly and Annual Reports shall include:

- Total Number of Use of Force cases ~~presented to the Chair.~~
- Total Number of Use of force ~~cases incidents~~ where the board issued an advisory ~~position~~ opinion finding a violation of law, policy, or procedure
- ~~Total number of use of force incidents reviewed~~
- Total Number of Vehicle Pursuits ~~given to the Chair~~
- ~~Total number of Vehicle Pursuits given to the Board~~
- Total Number of ~~CRB Member~~ Ride-alongs

~~Procedures for reporting to the city council, etc., require the information to be collected and formed into a public presentable form. This information shall be added, in its entirety, to the appropriate CRB meeting agenda. The CRB shall vote to accept the information to be presented.~~

~~Upon CRB acceptance the information, it shall be forwarded to the City Recorder or designee, so that the information may be added to the agenda for an upcoming City Council meeting agenda, where time allows.~~

~~The Chair will present this information to the City Council at the designated City Council Meeting.~~

~~All Reports shall be posted on the CRB webpage.~~

SECTION 7 - Supplemental

This document shall be reviewed ~~annually, a maximum of three (3) years from the date of approval,~~ or when there are changes in policies or procedures, ordinance, or statutes.

This document shall be available to the public.

Recommendation to South Salt Lake Police Department:

Case number LK2024-3081. On January 30, 2024 at approximately 3:19 am, a male subject was spotted by an officer walking in the middle of the road. This is a violation of Utah State Code 41-6Q-1002. The officer drove closer to the male subject to conduct a pedestrian stop. The male subject continued across the lanes of travel and onto the sidewalk. At this time the officer pulled up next to the male subject and asked the male subject to sit down. The male subject asked why, but didn't immediately comply. The officer stated that the male subject would get sprayed (Oleoresin Capsicum Spray) if he didn't sit down. The male subject continued to ask why. There was no explanation of why the male subject should sit down. The male subject was subsequently OC Sprayed.

With respect to case LK2024-3081, the officers involved were within policy as it pertains to use of force, and while the CRB agrees with this, the CRB makes the following recommendation.

The CRB asks the SSL PD to reiterate via training, both to the officer(s) involved and to the department the best practices of stating purposes for stops and detainment where possible. This may include time for de-escalation and distance from the subject for safety.

Note: Given that the formal recommendation is delayed, the CRB is aware that such training has already occurred and thanks the department for the responsiveness to the CRB's input.

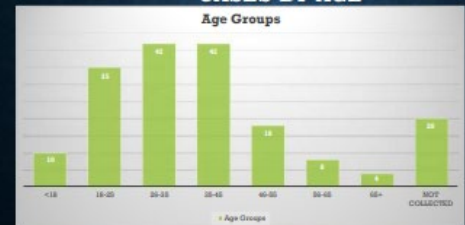

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CASES BY AGE



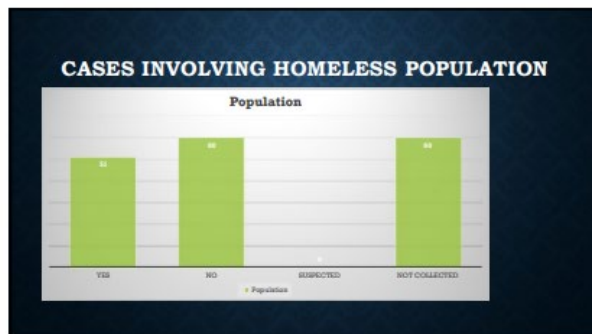
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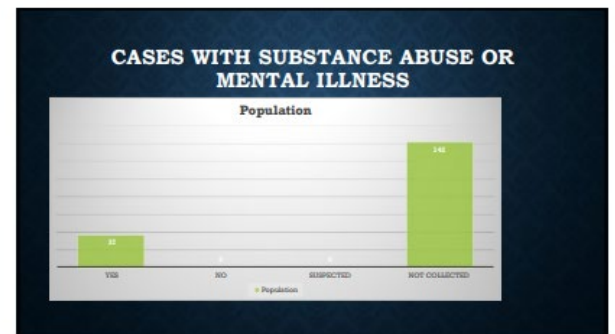
