Background:

The Utah Data Research Center (UDRC) houses the data infrastructure and employs the researchers who will conduct research on behalf of the Utah State Board of Education (USBE). The UDRC is a multi-agency collaboration that includes the Utah State Board of Education (USBE), the Utah System of Higher Education (USHE), the Department of Workforce Services (DWS), the Division of Disability and Rehabilitation Services (UDHR), and the Utah Department of Commerce (UDC).

Each of the data submitting partners has the opportunity annually to submit research priorities that the UDRC governance group will review and use to create the main research agenda. The list of currently available research items can be found at the following website:
