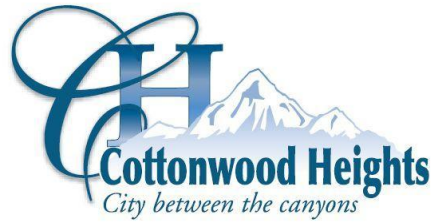

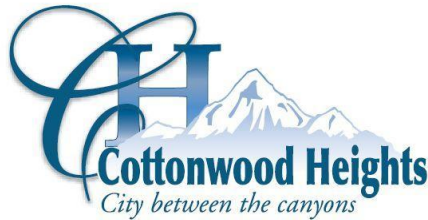

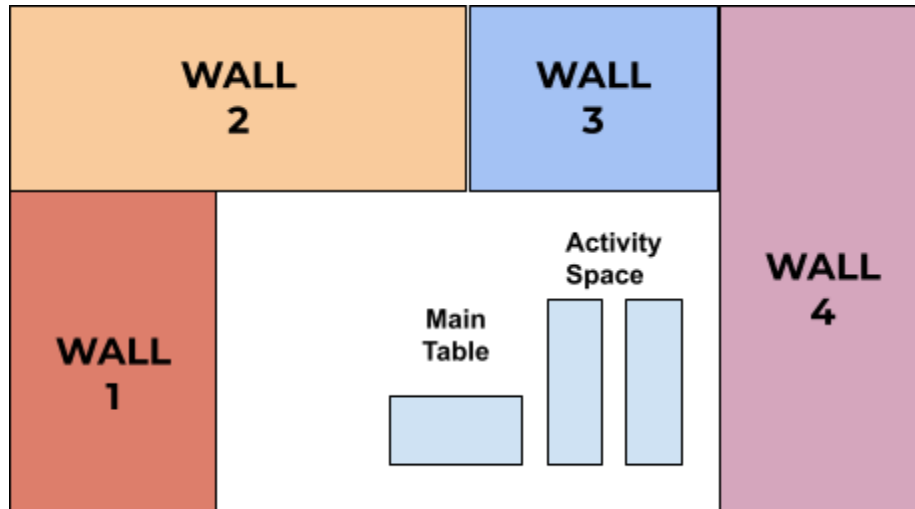


Historic Committee 2025 Exhibit Planning
