Call to Order

Chairman Nolan Davis called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Consent Issues

- a. Consent issues including financial reports, approval of bills and payroll, approval of minutes

*MOTION: Board Member Robin Bradshaw moved to approve the consent issues as presented.

Old Business

- a. Discuss curbside service in the Grove Area and meeting with Beaver City: Chairman Nolan Davis and Manager Mike Neilsen meet with Mayor Robinson and City Manager Jason Brown of Beaver City. They are on board to set up a town hall meeting with the residents of the Grove Area to get their opinions and ideas in regards to adding curb side service. Beaver City said they would help the District prepare for the meeting and get the information out to the residents. The Grove Area is the first area Waste Management wants to begin with and then will move out to the rest of the county. The District wants to focus on this area so they can eliminate the dumpsters at the Ball Fields/Rodeo Grounds as they are a problem. The Board Members all agree that a Town Hall Meeting is a good idea to get the information out to the residents and they may have suggestions to help with the transition. Board Member Robin Bradshaw mentions, when would be a good time to schedule this meeting. Manager Mike Neilsen mentions that Beaver City confirmed that the Navajo Trail Road is a county road. Commissioner Yardley confirms this as well. Hughes and Sons does have concerns about a turnaround for the garbage truck and Commissioner Yardley states he has drove up into the Grove Area and Wiley is right there are no turnaround spots. Attorney Von Christiansen calls into the meeting as he is on his way. Commissioner Yardley asks Von about the easements and right aways. Von says they have some but don't have them all. Some roads are still private. Folks will have to wheel their cans to the nearest road. Commissioner Yardley suggests meeting with Kevin Wicker to work on a map to see the easements and county right aways and what the road conditions are whether they are private or county roads. Commissioner Yardley will get with Kevin Wicker and have him start working on some maps. There needs to be access for the

garbage truck to be able to service this area. Commissioner Yardley will also get with Cory Beebe and have some information for the February 20th meeting. At that time the board will discuss scheduling a town hall meeting in March.

Executive Session: Purpose of discussing personnel.

MOTION: Board Member Robin Bradshaw moved to close the open meeting and move into Executive Session at 6:30 P.M. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Yardley. Roll call votes were as follows; Commissioner Yardley – Yes, Robin Bradshaw – Yes, Kade Blackner – Yes, Jack McMullin – Yes, Chairman Nolan Davis – Yes.

Those in attendance for the closed session were Chairman Nolan Davis, Attorney Von Christiansen, Commissioner Yardley, Board Members Robin Bradshaw, Kade Blackner, Jack McMullin, John Carter, Manager Mike Neilsen, and Secretary Kaylee Acklin.

Board Members moved back in the regular meeting at 7:10 P.M.

Robin Bradshaw commented by consensus of the board as of today the District will not pay the fuel surcharge under \$3.80 a gallon.

Comments

Board Member Jack McMullin has a letter from Minersville Town Council and Chairman Nolan Davis reads aloud to the board. Minersville Town has some concerns about the billing of the garbage fees to its residents. All of the Cities bill out the garbage fees on their sewer and water bill. The Cities collect the money and pay it to Waste Management Serv District 5 monthly. The Cities are paid \$.50 for each first can and \$.05 for each second can. The Cities are sending out the monthly bill regardless whether there is a garbage fee on the bill or not to the resident. If the Cities do not send out the billing on the garbage fee it will not save them any money. Commissioner Yardley mentions, this is not a fee we can change at this time as we have already set our budget for 2025 and the board can look at it again when they start working on the budget for 2026 if Minersville Town would like to discuss it at that time.

Manager Mike Neilsen had to leave the meeting early and would like secretary Kaylee Acklin to discuss with the Board the concerns Beaver City has had with many damaged garbage cans throughout the City of Beaver. Beaver City has had some complaints about damaged cans and can request not taking care of in a timely manner. Residents will normally call the Cities if there is a problem with their garbage can, whether it needs to be replaced, lid fixed, or a wheel fixed. The Cities will email Kaylee with the request and it is then forwarded to Hughes & Son's. This is done so there is a paper trail of the can request. Secretary also keeps a list of these requests. Once the can request is taken care of, Tiffany with Hughes will email over the can numbers and Kaylee will notify the Cities the request is completed. Manager Mike Neilsen has spoken with Wiley and would like him to start replacing cans before the residents have to call. If Wiley notices a can is damaged it needs to be replaced. Kaylee mentions to the Board, Wiley has already started replacing cans. Hughes & Son's has emailed over a list of can numbers that have been

replaced throughout Beaver City. The Board would like secretary to keep on top of the requests and follow up within a couple of weeks to make sure the request is completed.
