DISCUSSION TOPICS – CITY COUNCIL MEETING**

22 OCTOBER 2014

WHAT THE COMMITTEE HAS BEEN DOING:

- [] PREPARED AN INVENTORY OF ALL OPEN SPACE IN THE CITY WITH LOCATION, OWNERSHIP AND CITY COUNCIL DISTRICT.
- [] PARTICIPATED IN TAYLORSVILLE DAYZZ ACTIVITIES
- [] BEAUTIFICATION AWARDS CONTINUES TO BE A WORK IN PROGRESS
- [] TRACKING THE PROGRESS OF LITTLE CONFLUENCE SITE IMPROVEMENTS PROVIDED BY SALT LAKE COUNTY
- [] FIELD TRIPS TO VARIOUS PARK DEVELOPMENT AND IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS WITHIN THE VALLEY
- [] LAYING THE GROUNDWORK FOR RESIDENTIAL HALLOWEEN AND CHRISTMAS DECORATION RECOGNITION
- [] ANOTHER SUCCESSFUL COMMUNITY GARDEN PROGRAM THIS YEAR
- [] WORKING WITH COMMUNITY COUNCILS TO ENCOURAGE REPRESENTATION ON THE LARP COMMITTEE AND PARTICIPATE IN LARP RELATED ISSUES
- [] FORWARDING LARP RELATED RESOURCES TO THE CITY ADMINISTRATION

SOME THINGS THE COMMITTEE WOULD LIKE TO SEE HAPPEN:

BE BETTER INFORMED ABOUT WHAT IS HAPPENING IN THE CITY IN OUR AREAS OF INTEREST – LEISURE ACTIVITIES, RECREATION AND PARKS DEVELOPMENT.

EXAMPLES:

- [] WHAT DEVELOPMENT IS UNDERWAY AT RIVERSIDE PARK WHERE THE FREEDOM SHRINE IS LOCATED?
- [] WHAT IS HAPPENING WITH THE LABRUM PARK DEVELOPMENT AND IS IT POSSIBLE TO HAVE SOME PUBLIC INPUT?
- [] WHAT IS HAPPENING WITH THE URBAN TRAIL SYSTEM?
- [] IS THE CITY GOING TO MAKE APPLICATION FOR NEW ZAP FUNDS IF THE INITIATIVE ELECTION IS PASSED?
- [] IS THERE A CITY PARK DEVELOPMENT AND/OR IMPROVEMENT MASTER PLAN?
- [] A RESPONSE FROM THE CITY TO THE QUESTIONS SUBMITTED TO THE CITY COUNCIL DURING THE LARP COMMITTEE REPORT ON 16 APRIL.
- [] A CONFIRMATION THAT THE RESOURCES THIS COMMITTEE OFFERS ARE REALLY OF INTEREST OR VALUE TO THE CITY.

THE COMMITTEE WOULD LIKE TO PROMOTE AND BE INVOLVED IN THE FOLLOWING:

1. DEVELOP A "REMEMBER ME GARDEN". WE UNDERSTANT THAT THERE HAVE BEEN DISCUSSION REGARDING THE NAMING OF STREETS, PARKS, OR OTHER FACILITIES FOR INDIVIDUALS WHO HAVE CONTRIBUTED TO THE BETTERMENT OF THE CITY. WE PROPOSE TO CREATE A ROSE GARDEN THAT WOULD ALLOW GROUPS OR INDIVIDUALS TO PLANT A ROSE WITH A NAME PLAQUE, AT THEIR OWN EXPENSE, AS A REMEMBRANCE OF A SPECIAL PERSON. THE MEMORIAL WOULD REQUIRE CITY APPROVAL.

POSSIBLE LOCATIONS ARE: THE SENIOR CENTER SITE, RIVERSIDE PARK WHERE THE FREEDOM SHRINE IS LOCATED, THE CITY CENTER PROPERTY; THE TAYLORSVILLE CEMETARY, TAYLORSVILLE PARK, THE UDOT PROPERTY PARK, OR LABRUM PARK.

2. CREATE A CITY ICE SKATING POND DURING THE WINTER AT THE CITY CENTER PROPERY OR ONE OF THE CITY RETENTION BASINS FOR CITIZEN GATHERING AND ENJOYMENT.
3. PARTICIPATION IN PREPARATION OF A LONG-TERM PARKL DEVELOPMENT AND IMPROVEMENT PLAN FOR ALL OPEN SPACE PROPERTIES WITHIN THE CITY.
4. ESTABLISH A CITY HARVEST FESTIVAL UTILIZING THE COMMUNITY GARDEN AND THE TAYLORSVILLE HISTORIC SITE. PLANNING IS UNDERWAY FOR NEXT YEAR.
