Call to Order

Chairman Nolan Davis called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Consent Issues

a. Consent issues including financial reports, approval of bills and payroll, approval of minutes

*MOTION: Board Member Robin Bradshaw moved to approve the consent issues as presented.
Motion was seconded by Board Member John Carter. All were in favor, motion carried.*

Old Business

a. Discuss curbside service in the Grove Area and look over maps: Commissioner Yardley had Stetson Yardley attend the meeting to go over the maps of the Grove area with the Board Members. Stetson works for the Beaver County Road Crew and is more familiar with this area. Manager Mike Neilsen lets the Board know he drove into Holdaway Lane. There is a good turnaround area up Holdaway Lane and no issues to the gate. Four residents in that area would need to leave their cans by the main road, which manager suggests some stakes and bungy cords could be used to hold the cans so the residents are not having to haul their cans back and forth. There is no access into Holly Lane because of the bridge and there are seven homes in that area. Navajo trail has the new bridge and there is access to homes but there are a few homes with no turnarounds for the garbage truck. Again, some residents will need to bring their cans to a main road. Cotton Tree Lane is a very narrow and private roads. There is also a gate that blocks access to some homes. There are many turnarounds in the Grove Area and many dead ends that might cause a headache to figure out at first but manager brings the attention to the Board that there are roads and subdivisions in Beaver with not turnarounds and roads that are very narrow. The garbage truck has been driving into these areas for years and backing all the way out and it doesn't bother anyone. The District needs to be transparent with the residents and they will more than likely be happy for curbside service. Manager says the biggest challenge will be the road behind the Golf Course and Cotton Tree Lane. Board Members feel that curbside service is do-able and there are going to be some challenges but with a town hall meeting and getting the residents input they may be able to solve

these challenges. Board Members suggest having Wiley come to next month's meeting to get a better plan so when they hold a town hall meeting the Board and Wiley will have all the information for the residents. Manager would also like to go into the Grove Area and discuss with some of the residents our ideas. The Board will invite Wiley to attend next month's meeting and then plan for a Town Hall meeting in April. Manager also ask's Stetson Yardley, if gravel is needed in some areas, would the County Road be willing to spread it for us. Chairman Nolan Davis will speak with the County Commissioners to get an approval.

b. Discuss and resolve fuel surcharge: Manager discusses with the Board from last meeting he feels like the fuel surcharge did not get resolved and there is still confusion. He thinks where a motion was made to approve the fuel surcharge, and a motion needs to be made whether they discontinue the fuel surcharge or only pay past the base rate from the original contract. The Board discuss further and would like to discontinue the fuel surcharge all together and ask Wiley to attend next month's meeting if he is needing a rate increase.

MOTION: Board Member Robin Bradshaw moved to discontinue the fuel surcharge. Motion was seconded by Board Member Kade Blackner. All were in favor, motion carried.
