

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE RUSH VALLEY TOWN COUNCIL
HELD ON SEPTEMBER 24, 2014, AT THE RUSH VALLEY TOWN HALL, 52 SOUTH
PARK STREET, RUSH VALLEY, UTAH. THE MEETING BEGAN AT 7:00 P.M.

REGULAR AGENDA:

1. Roll Call. Mayor Brian Johnson commented the local Cub Scout troop is going to perform the flag ceremony for the meeting and lead us in the Pledge of Allegiance. Present at the meeting were Mayor Johnson, Council Members William Harding and Alan Anderton. Pete Albrecht and Dana Gardner were excused.

2. Approval of meeting minutes for 08/27/14. Mayor Johnson made a motion to approve the meeting minutes as presented. Alan Anderton seconded the motion. All present voted in favor and the motion carried.

3. Consideration of Ordinance Restricting Fireworks. Mayor Johnson asked Attorney Linares to draft an ordinance to restrict fireworks, so if there is a need to impose restrictions a special meeting doesn't need to be called. William Harding made a motion to accept the ordinance to allow the Mayor or Fire Chief to impose the restrictions. Alan seconded the motion all present voted in favor and the motion carried.

4. Consideration of replacing propane line to town hall. Mayor Johnson commented that with the new water line the propane line will need to be moved. The estimate to do this work is \$1,000.00. There is not a problem with the current propane line. Alan Anderton made a motion to move the propane line and authorize up to \$1,000.00 to cover the cost. William Harding seconded the motion. All present voted in favor and the motion carried.

5. Council Reports.

Cemetery. Alan commented he is preparing the cemeteries for Veterans Day and will be mowing for the last time this year. Mayor Johnson commented he received many comments about the book with information on cemeteries which was made available for people to view at Rush Valley Days.

Roads. William commented the weeds along Russell Lane have been mowed.

Mayor Johnson commented he negotiated with the IRS and the town has received the papers with the final offer. They will only review one year, 2012, and if we agree to comply to collect payroll taxes from required employees and not collect taxes from contact employees the amount due will be \$263.77 with no other penalties. Mayor Johnson thanked Amie for her work in collecting information requested. Lacey Burrows asked if there was a specific dollar amount required to start collecting taxes. Mayor Johnson commented that if a town employee is paid \$1.00 taxes have to be withheld. This new requirement will be starting in January 2015.

6. Safety Topic. William Harding reminded the council member to be aware of speed limits and follow them. He also reminded the importance of using safety restraints and to drive alert and sober.

7. Payment of Bills. Alan Anderton made a motion to pay the bills as written. Mayor Johnson seconded the motion. All present voted in favor and the motion carried.

8. Public Comments. There were no public comments offered.

9. Adjourn. Alan Anderton made a motion to adjourn. William Harding seconded the motion. All present voted in favor and the motion carried and the meeting was adjourned.
