Mayor Sim Bell started the meeting @ 7:30 PM with the pledge of allegiance. Jacob Hansen was planning on coming tonight to review the Subdivision Plan that he updated for us, but he had car problems on the way up. Brieanna never got back to April about coming to the meeting tonight to discuss the Sub for Santa review.

Minutes were reviewed. Clay made a motion to accept the minutes. Brandon Miller 2nd. All in favor. Clay read the bills. Brandon Miller made a motion to accept the bills. Clay 2nd. All in favor. The bank statements were passed out to review. Funds were discussed for future road repairs and culverts.

We received \$100,000 for the Tourism Grant for the basketball/tennis courts. Clay said that we could do all the prep work and then talk to The Hunter Brothers and see what they would be willing to do it for. Sim wondered about talking to the commissioners about extending it into next year because \$100,000 will not cover the costs to replace it. We could ask for more money next year to go towards it. Clay said he would talk to one of the commissioners. Building a Rec Center was talked about.

Building Permit Application and Policy & Procedures update will be discussed next month. Lane Leases were discussed. Clay thinks that we need to look at each one. Sim said that we will need to send notice to all the current people that have leases.

.Gov emails and Website were discussed. The county tech guy, Brian, said that he could help us with it. April will continue to work with him on this.

Kathy was working on the AARP grant. We will discuss this next month.


The sidewalk on SR 16 out to the new subdivision was discussed.

Clay said that he is pretty sure that the State will be coming through this year to redo Main Street. He is wanting to cut down the curbing in front of his shop. He said that if he does the permitting, it will cost him \$5,000. If the town does the permitting for it, it will be free. He will pay for the concrete and the labor and do the paperwork for it. Everyone is good with that. He will proceed to work with Ben from UDOT and the State on this.

Sim has talked to our engineer, Bart, about the road work that we are planning on doing this summer. We will need to have the job bided out. Bart said that he will plan on having the biding documents ready in the next couple of weeks for us. Clay said that we need to redo the culvert by Dusty's house. He wants to have Kaleb do some repair on the roads, and fill in low spots before the roads get done. We will need to give notice to citizens if we need to do repairs on the right-aways. Sim wondered if we needed to do the culvert now, or if we could wait until next year. Everyone decided to use the money we have for the roads and then do the culvert next year. Kaleb said that he thinks Staker Parson is going to be doing the County's roads.
