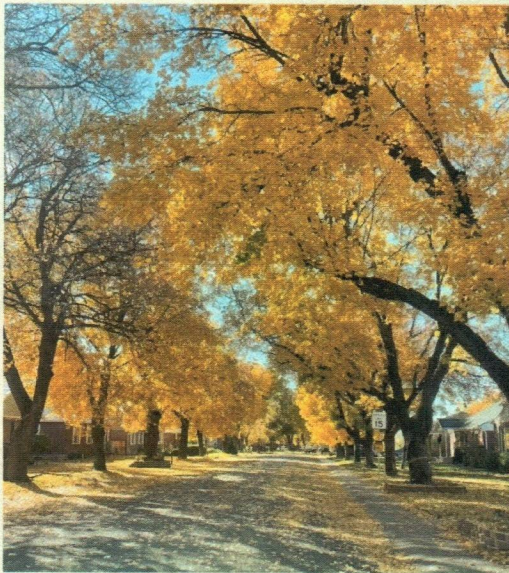


# It's time to repave Thornwood Drive

The meat was cooked over outdoor grills - and family members along the block furnished picnic tables and benches.

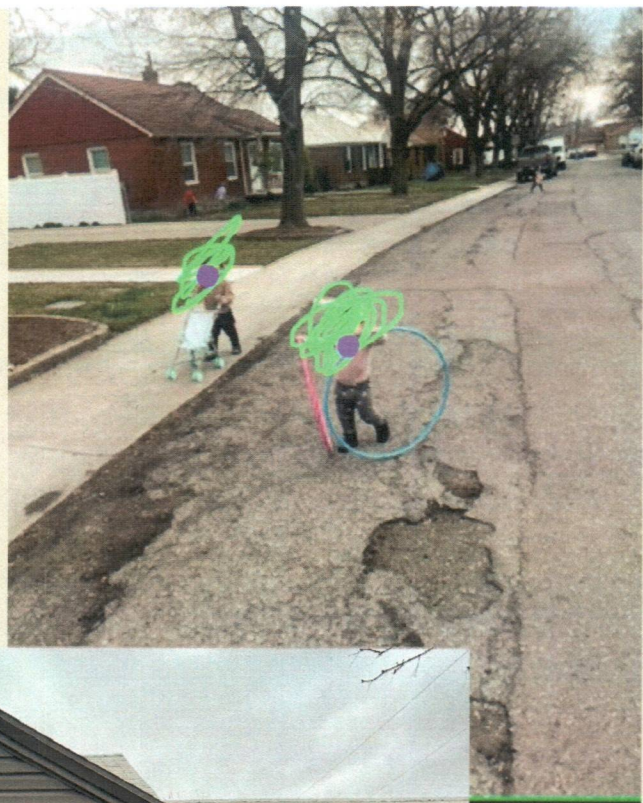
The street was blocked off from traffic during the interval of the party.
