Our Current Privacy Compliance Review

We review:

- Annual FERPA Notice
- Directory Information Notice
- Student Data
 Collection Notice
- Data Governance Plan
- MetadataDictionary

Current Timeline:

- Survey available in October
- Due in November
- Resubmissions due in February

Based on:

Requirements for compliance comes from <u>Board Rule</u> <u>277-487-3</u>

Requirements for notices comes from FERPA <u>Code</u> and <u>Regulations</u> and from <u>Utah Code 53E-9-3</u>

Compliance:


Districts and charters are considered compliant when all notices, policies, and metadata dictionary are comprehensive and up to date



The process works...so why change it?

Current Review

- Focus on **documentation**
- Same requirements for all LEAs
- **Same requirements** each year
- Compliance determined by completeness of documents
- **Little room** for improvement



Proposed Review

- Focus on **best practice**
- Individualized requirements based on needs of LEA
- Support implementation of privacy practices as required by <u>Government</u> <u>Data Privacy Act</u>
- More room for improvement



The Proposal

August

Determination of Focus Area

The USBE Student Data Privacy Team will determine an area of focus for the school year

- Leadership Practices
- Business Practices
- Data SecurityPractices
- Professional Development Practices
- Classroom Practices

October

LEAs Receive Survey

- Each district or charter will complete a self-assessment based on the focus for the year
- The self-assessment will consist of about 10-15 questions
- The results will help districts and charters identify areas of strength and improvement

November

LEAs Return Survey

By November 15, districts and charters will return the survey, including:

- The results of the self-assessment
- An identified goal or task to be completed by spring
- A plan for completion, including support from USBE

May

LEAs Report Results

During the school year, districts and charters will work toward their goal, with support and coaching as needed from USBE

In May, districts and charters will complete a survey to demonstrate completion of their goal or task
