A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE FISCAL YEAR 2025-2026 BUDGET

- 1. Adoption of Fiscal Year 2026 Budget.** The budget for fiscal year 2025-2026, as set forth in the attached exhibit is hereby approved and adopted.
- 2. Effective Date.** This Resolution is effective immediately upon passage.
