The candidate filing period is between June 2, 2025, and June 9, 2025, Monday through Monday, except weekends and holidays. A Declaration of Candidacy must be filed in person from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. at 485 E Shepard Lane, Kaysville Utah 84037.

Candidates must meet the following qualifications:

- Registered Voter in the district in which the individual is elected.
- Maintain a principal place of residence within the municipality, and district that the elected office represents, during the officer's term of office.
- Pay filing fee, if one is required by municipal ordinance.
- Not convicted of a felony.
- Cannot have been declared mentally incompetent.
