Legislative items are recommendations to the City Council. Broad public input will be taken and considered on each item. All legislative items recommended at this meeting will be scheduled for a decision at the next available City Council meeting.

- 4.1. Review and consider a recommendation to amend Chapter 10-34 of the Herriman City Code to (1) standardize the maximum height of accessory structures on 10,001 - 21,789 square foot lots at 20 feet regardless of the structure's "footprint" or square footage, (2) standardize the maximum height of accessory structures on lots that contain more than ½-acre at 25 feet regardless of the structure's "footprint" or square footage, (3) reduce the minimum rear and side yard setback requirement of accessory structures when adjacent to public open space to 3 feet, and (4) expand enforcement remedies in Chapter 10-7 of the Herriman City Code to include building height deviations no greater than 10% when substantial construction has been undertaken in good faith, subject to City approval. (Public Hearing)
