Access Policies

Logan Library patrons in good standing are allowed to use the makerspace equipment under the following conditions:

- All bookings are available on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Bookings up to two weeks in advance are strongly encouraged.
- Patrons must have a signed liability waiver on file before using any makerspace equipment.
- Patrons aged 18 and over may book makerspace equipment. Patrons under 18 are allowed to use the equipment if supervised by the adult who booked it.
- Patrons are limited to no more than 2 4-hour sessions per week. Please speak with library staff if you need additional time to complete your project.
- All equipment must be supervised by the booker while in operation.
- All bookings will end no later than 30 minutes before close.
- Staff reserve the right to refuse or end a booking early for reasons including, but not limited to, unsafe/inappropriate use of the equipment or other library policy violations.

Staff Procedures

- When a patron asks to use a piece of makerspace equipment, ask them if they already have a reservation. If not, check availability and make one for them.
- Confirm their reservation and mark them as having arrived.
- Walk them to the room and perform any necessary steps to get them onto their equipment. For example: log onto the computer as super user or retrieve the filament they wish to use.

- Remind them to please stop by the desk after their session and let staff know they're done using the equipment.
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
