Data Governance Working Group Update	Javaid Lal	- SLCo Privacy Program – Government Data Privacy Act - GDPA – Bill passed in 2024, governs collection, use, and protection of personal data by UT governmental entities - Program initiation deadline moved from 7/1/25 to 12/31/25 - Privacy Officer designees – agency decision – “Chief Administrative Officer” and “Records Officer” - Maren – each agency already has a designated records officer - Privacy/records coordinator – different title may be needed - Training requirement for contractors - Responsible for all data collected	Committee members to review role descriptions for overlap with required privacy officer designee requirements
