




Bennion Jr. Feeder Pattern Study




The Proposal:

Changing part of the
Bennion Jr. High boundary
such that it feeds ONLY into
Taylorsville High School







If Bennion Jr. Were to Feed Entirely Into Taylorsville High...

Taylorsville High would realize a net gain of
approximately 190 students *over a 2-3 year
period.*

Cottonwood High would realize a corresponding
net loss of 190 students *over a 2-3 year period.*

Considerations

- Almost 40% of the students that live in the Cottonwood High boundary are already permitting to Taylorsville High
- Taylorsville High has indicated that because of a recent decrease in enrollment and current classroom configurations, the increase in students could be absorbed without adding additional relocatable classrooms.

Travel time reduced and safety increased

The Taylorsville High School Community Council has articulated their support of this initiative and has expressed a desire to see all Taylorsville area residents return to their neighborhood school.
