SUMMARY:

Under State Code 10-3-818, before a governing body may adopt a final budget or a final amended budget that includes a compensation increase for an executive municipal officer, the body must hold a public hearing. For the purposes of this code section, "executive municipal officer" means all department heads and their chief assistants or deputies. As a fulfillment of the requirements of this code, Riverton City will be giving all executive municipal officers the same percentage increase as all other employees, namely a up to 4% Merit.
