Others in attendance: Kara Proctor, Bob Lloyd, Jess Peterson

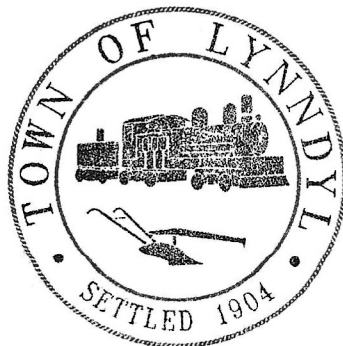
Mayor Proctor called the meeting to order and asked for a review of the minutes from the March meeting. Spencer made the motion to approve the minutes and Miff seconded. Mayor Proctor then called for a review of March financials and Matt made the motion to approve and Richard seconded. Minutes and financials were approved. Jess gave an update that we were approved for the CDBG grant to replace our water pump! There are quite a few things that we will need to do in order to accept and make sure we are in compliance to receive those grant funds. Jess will work with Kara to make sure that happens within the deadline.

Spencer mentioned that he would eventually like to see the town purchase a bigger bucket in order to help dig graves at the cemetery. With the equipment we have it takes a long time. We might consider increasing our open/close fee to \$700. Briar asked him to call around to some other communities to see what their open/close fees are currently before we make a change.

Miff said that the tractor needs a service, Spencer said Hermansen's has done it in the past-she says she will likely ask them to do it this time. We have some trailers blocking the alleyway and yield near Shiela Parks home-Miff will hopefully talk to them this month, the Mayor will speak to them next month if nothing changes. She is still in need of a roads employee especially as summer is approaching and there is more work to be done.

Richard said we might want to consider updating our building requirements to better include utilities like water. There was a discussion in regards to Chase Nielson's home being built. Richard also stated that Nick would like to resign as the town water operator. He doesn't have the time to do it anymore. Kara will post that job.

Kara mentioned that the dates for filing for elections has changed to June 2nd -6th. All applications have to be received in person. There is an R6 conference being held on May 6 from 5-9pm in Richfield, she reminded everyone to attend if possible. There was also a discussion in regards to the clerk job. Kara would like to hire someone to help and split the pay. The council agreed that now is a good time to consider training someone anyway as Kara was planning to resign in January, and this will allow time to ease in that transition. The council agreed and said she could post the job. Miff made a motion to adjourn the meeting and Matt seconded. Meeting adjourned.
