Mayor Proctor called the meeting to order and asked for everyone to review the minutes from December's meeting. Spencer made a motion to approve the minutes and Miff seconded. Mayor Proctor asked everyone to review the financials for December, Spencer made a motion to approve and Miff seconded. Financial reports for January were all reviewed, Spencer made the motion to approve and Miff seconded. Minutes and financial reports were all approved. Bob gave us an update for mosquito abatement. There is a new manager as the past manager has retired.

Jess took a few minutes and explained that he thinks we have a pretty good chance at the CDBG grant we submitted, but nothing will be known for a while. He also mentioned a possible grant for the parks, but council decided now might not be the best time to apply-we can look into it next year. Jess also said that he can draft us a subdivision ordinance if we need him to. He will look into if we've had it done already or not, and we can talk more about it next month.

Miff mentioned she would like an employee for summer, Scott will not be able to do it soon and she wants someone during the construction that will be coming through.

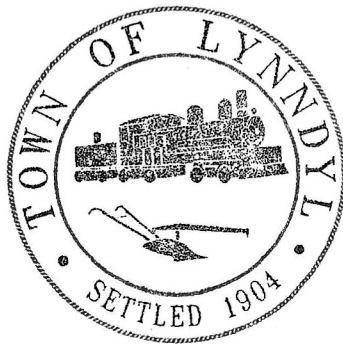
Planning and zoning mentioned that CentraCom has applied for a permit and they will start to do a little digging through town soon as part of their Leamington project.

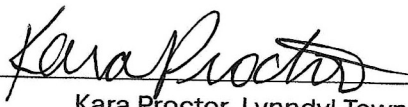
Richard mentioned that the construction on the new well house should begin at the end of February.
