Additionally, the detailed methodologies for hydrocarbon extraction and distillation processes, including the use of specialized equipment such as the PX1 system and VKS-70-5RS unit, constitute trade secrets that derive significant economic value from their confidentiality. Disclosure could enable competitors to replicate our processes, causing unfair competitive injury. These methods have been developed through substantial investment and are protected through restricted access and employee nondisclosure agreements. The company's interest in maintaining confidentiality outweighs any public interest in accessing this information, as it does not pertain to public health or safety, which are addressed through existing regulatory oversight. This protection ensures continued innovation and compliance with Utah Department of Agriculture and Food standards.
