Notes	A. K.B. The Committee discussed K.B.'s complaint. K.B.'s complaint listed several protective order violations and concerns with the lack of filing criminal cases from the violation. The Committee discussed the case that was filed that resulted in a plea in abeyance. It was a misdemeanor so it is unclear if she requested notifications or received them. Rachel reached out to K.B. to get clarification about the violations and complaint. K.B. was not made aware of hearing dates or of the plea offer. K.B. was never given an opportunity to speak to the judge. K.B. feels like they provided adequate information about violations, but the violations never went anywhere. The original case was a misdemeanor case with Murray City.

	B. J.R. The Committee discussed J.R.'s complaint. J.R. 's complaint is that they were not notified of the dismissal of their case. J.R. has also been unable to obtain information about the case through a GRAMA request. J.R. was present at the meeting. He told the Committee about his frustration with not knowing why the case was dismissed. J.R. has explored several avenues to get answers about his case, but feels like no one is willing to provide the answers. J.R. discussed his frustrations with the mayor of his city and city council. J.R. is afraid for the safety of his family and community. The response from West Valley City was read. J.R. shared a video of the incident that will be provided to the committee members. J.R. said that the video cuts off before the end of the incident. J.R. is not sure why the full video was not provided by the rec center.
