-Fees for use of Ballpark

This would be for teams who do not have fifty percent of their kids living in Gunnison, Mayfield, Axtell, Centerfield or Fayette.

-Future Ballfield plans (Playground)

Board Member Avery would like to see the building finished up, Board Member Dyreng and Rec Director Bracket would like to see new dirt put on the fields. Board Member Barclay would also like to see the dirt change as well as see the Concession stand up and running. And Mayor Leatherwood would like to have an agreement with the high school on a set date to turn on the water for bathrooms and concession stands.

-Baseball/Softball fields Trash Cans

Tyson got all the Trash Cans spread out and separated and then when the season is over he plans to pressure wash them and clean them out.

-Improvements for Rec Leagues

Robert would like to know what changes are going to be made to make Rec Leagues better and continue to make improvements. Tyson has changed a few of the dates for different seasons to try to help with sign ups so they won't conflict with their travel ball teams.
