DETAILED REASON AND EXPLANATION FOR REQUEST:

As part of the new interchange project, staff is recommending the implementation of select aesthetic improvements and betterments to enhance the visual appeal of the interchange area and support the installation of utility main lines. These utility lines will serve as critical infrastructure for future development along the Nebo Beltway corridor.

On April 15, 2025, a UDOT representative presented an overview of potential freeway interchange enhancements. Since that time, staff has reviewed and refined the list of potential betterments provided by the project team and is now seeking direction from the city council on which improvements should be prioritized for funding.

To assist in this effort, staff has prepared a narrowed list of recommended betterments for council consideration. If the city council is supportive of moving forward with any or all of

these enhancements, staff will proceed with gathering more detailed information, including cost estimates and potential funding sources, for future consideration.

This agenda request and any supporting documentation is due to the city recorder by the Wednesday one week prior to the council meeting. This allows final preparation of the agenda and time for the city attorney to review.
