<u>Approval of April 2025 Minutes:</u> A motion was made by John Blickenstaff to approve the April 15, 2025 meeting minutes as written. It was seconded by Roger LeFevre and passed unanimously.

He is preparing a spreadsheet to track coverage and is working on the new rate ordinance. There are some pre-work projects that the crew might accomplish before the project begins. Jody would like to thank the TLPOA for

supplying RFID tags for the contractors and engineers to enter through the homeowner gates when the project begins.

The crew has been performing routine maintenance on fire hydrants and pressure releasing valves.

Jody will invite the Wasatch County Fire Marshall to meet to share concerns and explain how the pressure system works.

<u>Other Business:</u> Steve Turley suggested exploring whether it would be beneficial to possibly sell or lease excess water rights. McKay Murdock will converse with Corbin Gordon and investigate the possibility.
