



Middle School Academic Report

Broken Windows Theory


Picture a building with a few broken windows.

If the broken windows are **not repaired**, people walking by will assume **no one cares** about the property. This creates an atmosphere of lawlessness.

Disorder invites disorder: more windows get broken, squatters may move in, crime eventually takes hold, etc.


Visible signs of disorder (even small ones) send a message that rules aren't enforced and **no one is in control**.

Social cues matter: People take cues from their environment. Clean, orderly spaces suggest rules are enforced.

 - **Social Cue:** orderly transitions and class time are valued




Suspension Days


- **2023-24 = 115**
