We had an amazing turnout for the Queen contest this year. We had 18 girls try out and over 150 spectators to support the Girls. Chris Price runs our contest and does a great job.

Old west Team Roping Horse Futurity

This was the first year for this event at our complex. It was held in Wallsburg at the Probst Ranch last year. They realized that their home was not the place for the event.

The roping started on Tuesday June 17 and was held in the outdoor arena where they roped for the remainder of the week. A total of 1.6 million was added for prize money, making this one of the richest roping's in the world. The very best in the roping world were here to test their skills. On Friday a total of 35 horses were auctioned selling for a staggering \$6.8 Million. The low end of the sale was \$30,000.00 and the high was \$1.7 Million yes for a horse. I still cannot believe that we had the event here it is an honor and a privilege to have it here. We sold every stall we could put together totaling around 500. We had to turn down a substantial number of people for stalls, sending them to Oakley and Spanish Fork for stalls. To keep and grow this event we will have to have more stalls included in our Master plan.

Enbridge Gas Rodeo

This is a competition put together by Enbridge to showcase their skills and compete against other divisions in our region. They are great to work with, it is a lot of fun to see them compete.





T-Ball/ Boys Coach Pitch

T-Ball 207 Participants BCP 255 Participants

This Program is a month long and the kids play games twice a week. Every game is an hour long and the kids all get to bat around 3 times, as well as play in the field. We give each coach a bat and a tee as well as a dozen soft baseballs for t-ball. The coaches will bring these to every game so there kids can play. I have a great group of coaches this year and the kids seem to be having a ton of fun.

Men's Softball

We will be playing at Vets Park and be using 2 fields on Monday Nights. This year we will have a combined league. We will follow the season with a double elimination tournament.

I make sure our grounds crew has all the information to prep the fields and that the fields are prepped. As well as coordinating with Umpires and having game balls for them. I will turn on the lights as the night goes on and off when we are finished. I stay at the park all night until games are over, answering any questions and taking care of any issues that come up.

Coed Softball

80 Participants

Coed Softball is played at Southfield Park. This year we are using two fields, Lloyd and Widd. Game times are 6:30, 7:30, 8:30pm on Wednesday nights with teams having double headers.
