AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING OFFICE OF ECHO CANYON MUNICIPAL ENGINEER AND APPOINTING ECHO CANYON ENGINEER

WHEREAS, Echo Canyon, Utah (“**Echo Canyon**”) was incorporated as a preliminary municipality pursuant to Utah Code Title 10, Chapter 2a, Part 5 on June 9, 2025; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Utah Code Section 10-2a-509(4)(B)(iii), a preliminary municipality has the same authority as another municipality to make decisions regarding zoning and land use; and

WHEREAS, under Utah Code Section 10-3-917, municipalities may by ordinance establish an office of the municipal engineer and prescribe the duties and obligations for that office; and

WHEREAS, to promote the health, safety, convenience, and general welfare of the present and future inhabitants of Echo Canyon desires to establish an office of the Echo Canyon Engineer and set forth provisions for the establishment, terms of appointment, and other related operations of the Echo Canyon Engineer; and

WHEREAS, Echo Canyon desires to appoint Horrocks LLC (“**Horrocks**”) to serve as Echo Canyon Engineer

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ECHO CANYON PRELIMINARY MUNICIPALITY BOARD AS FOLLOWS:

1. The office of Echo Canyon Engineer is hereby established.
2. The Echo Canyon Engineer is hereby designated as the land use authority, as defined in Utah Code Section 10-9a-102(40), for Echo Canyon. The Echo Canyon Engineer shall have all the powers and duties of a Land Use Authority set forth in Utah Code Title 10, Section 9a.
3. Each person appointed as an Echo Canyon Engineer shall be a registered professional engineer under Utah Code Title 58, Chapter 22, Professional Engineers and Professional Land Surveyors Licensing Act.
4. The Echo Canyon Engineer's office shall be the office of record for all maps, plans, plats, profiles, drawings, final estimates, specifications and contracts which in any way relate to the public improvements and engineering affairs of Echo Canyon pursuant to Utah Code Section 10-3-903. The Echo Canyon Engineer shall be custodian of all such drawings and documents and shall record and maintain all such drawing and documents in accordance with Utah Code Section 10-3-904.

5. Effective immediately, 2025, pursuant to Utah Code Section 10-3-917, Horrocks is appointed as the Echo Canyon Engineer to fulfill all applicable duties and responsibilities set forth in the Utah Code, Echo Canyon's ordinances, and all other applicable laws and regulations.

6. The Echo Canyon Preliminary Municipality Board ("**Board**") is authorized to take such steps as are necessary to implement this Ordinance.

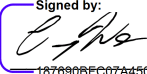
7. Severability. If any section, part or provision of this Ordinance is held invalid or unenforceable, such invalidity or unenforceability shall not affect any other portion of this Ordinance, and all sections, parts and provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable.

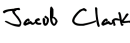
8. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon posting as required by law.
