# Mt. Pleasant City Ordinance No. 2025-04 AN ORDINANCE REGULATING PARADE SEATING, PARKING, AND USE OF PUBLIC PROPERTY PRIOR TO THE HUB CITY DAYS PARADE

## Section 1: Early Reservation or Occupation of Public Property Prohibited

It shall be unlawful for any person to claim, reserve, occupy, or attempt to claim, reserve, or occupy—either in person or by the placement of ropes, tents, chairs, sleeping bags, blankets, or other devices or barriers—any public property as a position for observing the **Hub City Days Parade** prior to 6:00 p.m. on the day before the parade.

Nothing in this section shall permit any person to occupy a position on a public street or right-of-way, obstruct a public sidewalk, or occupy any location deemed unsafe or likely to cause damage to public or private property.

### **Section 2: Parking Restrictions Along the Parade Route**

Beginning at 11:00 p.m. on the evening prior to the Hub City Days Parade, and continuing until the conclusion of the parade, it shall be unlawful to park any motor vehicle or trailer on public streets designated as part of the official parade route.

Vehicles or trailers parked in violation of this section shall be considered a public nuisance and may be towed immediately at the owner's expense.

### **Section 3: Authorized Exceptions**

This ordinance shall not prevent Mt. Pleasant City, its Parade or Special Event Committees, or other authorized individuals or organizations, from reserving public spaces for parade observation or erecting and managing seating or structures on public property for the same purpose. Such activities shall only be conducted under a valid permit issued by Mt. Pleasant City.

#### **Section 4: Violations and Penalties**

Any person who violates any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a **Class C Misdemeanor** and subject to fines or other penalties as provided by Utah State Law and the Mt. Pleasant City Municipal Code.

### **Section 5: Effective Date**

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon publication and posting as required by law.
