MINUTES OF THE STUDY SESSION – JUNE 17, 2025

The Board of Education of the Alpine School District met in a study session on Tuesday, June 17, 2025, at 4:00 PM. The study session took place in the boardroom at the Alpine School District office.

Board members present: Board President Julie E. King, Vice Presidents Stacy M. Bateman and Emily B. Peterson, Sarah L. Beeson, Dr. Mark J. Clement, Joylin Lincoln, and Ada S. Wilson.

Also present: Superintendent Dr. Shane J. Farnsworth, Business Administrator Jason Sundberg, and members of the administrative staff. There were 25 others in attendance.

1. Annual Health Report and Assurances

Jessica Benson, Content Specialist for Health & PE, presented the annual health report. She shared that a committee comprised of a board member, curriculum director, school nurse, parents, and a teacher met on April 17th for the policy assurances meeting. The new secondary items approved were videos regarding healthy boundaries as a part of the Health I and II curriculum. The health science and CTE teacher requirements include USBE and ASD training every three years, and Botvin training and curriculum. All health teachers must be endorsed or on an associate endorsement and all health/health science teachers must use items from the approved materials list.

2. FY26 Tentative Budget

Bea Twede, Director of Budgets, reviewed the FY26 Budget Book. She explained that the enrollment projections that are presented in October are the beginning point for the following year's budget. The FY26 Budget Book is available on the business services page of the Alpine District website. (https://alpineschools.org/business/)

Jason Sundberg, Business Administrator, clarified that as a part of the 2025 Utah State Legislative Session, SB188 includes a provision that Alpine School District will allocate \$60 per student to each of the new divided districts in January 2026 and January 2027 based on the most current October 1st headcount. The projection for the January 2026 allocation is approximately \$5 million. The budgeted allocation is shown throughout the report as part of the District Administration expenses in the General Fund. Jason also discussed the revenue and debt services and the Truth in Taxation option. The business team's recommendation was an increase of four increments which would show as a 7% increase on the Truth in Taxation notice. However, the debt service rate will decrease by three increments and the net to homeowners would be one increment. This would stabilize the tax rate through the split and would setup the new school boards with a revenue source. The county will need to be notified by Monday if the school board chooses to go through Truth in Taxation on August 5th.

3. Report from Student Support Services

Amie Sisam, Director of Student Support Services (outgoing), and Dr. Kim Jones, the incoming director, presented on the following goals:

1. Student Achievement

- Provide a multi-tiered system of behavior support to meet the needs of students.
- Provide support in the administration and analysis of the Culture, Climate, and Connection Survey.

2. Teacher Effectiveness

- Implement a three-year strategic plan for behavior to support administrators, teachers, coaches, and other stakeholders.
- Provide tools and resources to support administrators in district policies, practices, and processes.
- Improve the clarity, consistency, and usability of student records in the student information system (SIS) to support teaching, learning, and school operations.

• Leveraging Service Providers Teams by building the efficacy of service provider groups to improve student well-being.

3. Stakeholder Engagement

- Improve internal communication: Service provider teams have regular communication (includes administrator).
- ASD Community Outreach: Increased education for administrators and community outreach team members. Expand and improve partnerships with community organizations to better support families and students.

4. <u>District Athletic Director Title IX Report</u>

Matt Norman, District Athletic Director, presented the Title IX Report for Alpine School District. This is required reporting at the beginning of each year. There are 26 sports in ASD and we will be adding esports next year. Matt highlighted that 9,427 students participated in sports in the 2024-25 school year.

The LEA license applications were included for the board's review.

5. School LAND Trust Amendments

The School LAND Trust amendments were included for the board's review.

Superintendent Farnsworth recommended approval of the routine business. Joylin Lincoln motioned to approve the routine business, Stacy Bateman seconded it, and the motion passed unanimously.

ACTION ITEM

1. FY25 Final Budget

Superintendent Farnsworth recommended approval of the FY25 Final Budget. Ada Wilson made the motion to approve the FY25 Final Budget, it was seconded by Emily Peterson, and the motion passed unanimously.

2. FY26 Tentative Budget

Superintendent Farnsworth recommended approval of the FY26 Tentative Budget. Jason Sundberg, Business Administrator, explained that the vote for the tentative budget includes the current tax rate, but it could change with the Truth in Taxation hearing on August 5th. Board Members noted that in this budget, 73% of the general fund goes to teaching and learning. Ada Wilson made the motion to approve the FY26 Tentative Budget, it was seconded by Stacy Bateman, and the motion passed unanimously.

- 3. The Middle & High School Boundary Adjustments for the Wild Flower Development in Saratoga Springs
 Eric Woodhouse, Executive Director of Operations and Derek Farnes, Director of Operational Analytics,
 reviewed the two boundary options and the feedback received from patrons. Option A aligns the middle and
 high school boundaries with the elementary boundary change made last year. Option B keeps the secondary
 boundaries as they are currently. The recommendation from the operations team is Option A. This option would
 keep the Black Ridge community together and the future growth of the Wild Flower area would be better
 accommodated at Sage Canyon Middle and Cedar Valley High because of the schools' lower enrollment. Board
 President Julie King acknowledged it is a longer distance to Cedar Valley High and bussing will be available.

 Julie King made the motion to adopt Option A for the Wild Flower secondary school boundary, Joylin
 Lincoln seconded it, and the motion passed unanimously.
- 4. The Elementary & Secondary School Boundary Adjustments for the Inverness Development in Lehi
 The two boundary options for the elementary, middle, and high school students in the Inverness Development were reviewed, along with the feedback from patrons. The public feedback addressed concerns about proximity to schools because Inverness is closer to Lehi. Derek Farnes explained that there are additional plans for homes beyond 2029 and Inverness will be too large to be absorbed into one elementary school. To keep the pure feeders together, the secondary boundary line has also been adjusted. There is a natural break between the development of plots B and D, which is where the boundary line is drawn. The recommendation from the operations team is Option A. Stacy Bateman made the motion to adopt Option A for the Inverness boundary and it was seconded by Sarah Beeson. Board Member Bateman acknowledged this is a solution for the next few years and that a larger boundary study needs to be completed for all of Lehi. The board voted and the motion to adopt Option A passed unanimously.

5. 2025-26 School Fee Schedule & Spend Plans

Superintendent Farnsworth recommended approval of the 2025-26 School Fee Schedule & Spend Plans. Mark Clement made the motion to approve the fee schedule and spend plans, it was seconded by Ada Wilson, and the motion passed unanimously.

6. Resolution 2025-009 – Sale of CTE Home in Orem

Superintendent Farnsworth recommended approval of Resolution 2025-009, the sale of the CTE home in Orem. Sarah Beeson made the motion to approve Resolution 2025-009, it was seconded by Ada Wilson, and the motion passed unanimously.

7. Resolution 2025-010 – Sale of CTE Home in Lehi

Superintendent Farnsworth recommended approval of Resolution 2025-010, the sale of the CTE home in Lehi. Joylin Lincoln made the motion to approve Resolution 2025-010, it was seconded by Stacy

Bateman, and the motion passed with six votes in favor and Sarah Beeson abstaining due to a conflict of interest.

DISCUSSION/ACTION ITEMS

1. 2026 Board Meeting Schedule

Superintendent Farnsworth recommended approval of the 2026 board meeting schedule following a discussion by the board. Ada Wilson made the motion to approve the board meeting schedule for 2026, Sarah Beeson seconded it, and the motion passed unanimously.

- 2. Policy 4162 Health and Disability (Adopt the postpartum & parental leave required by state statute)
 Superintendent Farnsworth recommended approval of the updates to Policy 4162. Kraig Brinkerhoff,
 Executive Director of Legal Services, clarified that this policy is for certified employees and that the changes match those made in state law. Joylin Lincoln made the motion to approve Policy 4162, Emily Peterson seconded it, and the motion passed unanimously.
- 3. Policy 4412 Health and Disability Leave (Adopt postpartum & parental leave required by state statute parental leave highlights.)

Superintendent Farnsworth recommended approval of the updates to Policy 4412. This policy is for the support professionals. Ada Wilson made the motion to approve Policy 4412 and Julie King seconded it. Ada clarified that we have had this policy in place, but the updates are to align with changes in state law. The board voted and the motion passed unanimously.

4. Policy 5250 - Electronic Communication & Devices

Superintendent Farnsworth recommended approval of Policy 5250. Kraig Brinkerhoff explained that this policy is in response to changes in state law. The state gave a base for what the restrictions can be and the district can add to them if they choose to do so. We adopted what the legislation said and we adjusted it based on grade level. We also made allowances for the individual schools to make changes with input from their SCCs. Any changes made by the schools cannot be looser than the policy. Julie asked for clarification on the containers the devices are to be put in and who is responsible for them. This stayed as a discussion item and no action was taken at this time.

5. Policy 4078 - Bullying Policy (retire)

Superintendent Farnsworth recommended approval to retire Policy 4078. Ada Wilson made the motion to retire Policy 4078, it was seconded by Joylin Lincoln, and the motion passed unanimously.

6. Policy 5181- Bully Policy (retire)

Superintendent Farnsworth recommended approval to retire Policy 5181. Joylin Lincoln made the motion to retire Policy 5181, Emily Peterson seconded it, and the motion passed unanimously.

7. Policy 7110 - Bullying Prevention (combined)

Superintendent Farnsworth recommended approval of Policy 7110. Mark Clement made the motion to approve Policy 7110, Sarah Beeson seconded it, and the motion passed unanimously.

REPORTS

1. Membership Report

Superintendent Farnsworth reported that the enrollment trends have occurred throughout the year.

Stacy Bateman shared that the Alpine Foundation went to Windsor Elementary for the STARS Summer Reading Program. She thanked the individuals who help make the program possible and are willing to help students.

Superintendent Farnsworth honored Scott Sumner and Dr. Analis Ruiz, two members of the district's senior leadership team. Scott Sumner is retiring and Dr. Ruiz has accepted a position with the Salt Lake City School District. He recognized them for their great work in ASD.

Julie King thanked all of the employees who are busy in the schools getting the buildings ready for the next year.

Joylin Lincoln shared information about the groundbreaking of the new high school in Saratoga Springs, on Friday, June 20th at 2:00 PM.
