COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PUBLIC HEARING:

Mayor Ren Hatt opened the second public hearing for the CDBG program. Mayor Hatt stated that this hearing was called to allow all citizens to provide input concerning the project that was awarded under the 2025 Community Development Block Grant Program. The City of Green River has amended its capital investment plan and decided to apply for funds for the "Main Street Infrastructure Upgrade-Plan" at Green River, Utah. The Mayor/Commissioner explained that the application was successful in the regional rating and ranking process and the city's "Main Street Infrastructure Upgrade-Plan" was awarded a Grant Amount of \$53,151.

The Mayor explained the project to those in attendance. The Mayor then asked for any comments, questions, and concerns from the audience. There were no questions. The mayor decided to wait several minutes to allow questions or comments
