CALL TO ORDER/ INTRODUCTIONS

The meeting was called to order by Commissioner Meyeres, Chairperson of the Authority Board.

APPROVAL OF MAY MINUTES

Commissioner Meyeres asked for a motion to approve the May 2025 Authority Board minutes. Commissioner Taylor moved to adopt the minutes and Commissioner Cozzens seconded the motion. The minutes were unanimously approved.

FY2025 BUDGET PUBLIC APPROVAL

Mr. Deal reminded the Board of the lengthy discussion in last month's Board meeting/Public Hearing regarding the FY2026 Annual Operating and Capital Budget.

Mr. Deal distributed the Annual Financial Plan for Fiscal Year 2026 and quickly reviewed the Annual Financial Plan. Mr. Deal stated the document is a description of the Center's financial assumptions and internal controls in relation to the budget, and revenue sources.

Mr. Deal moved on to the FY 2026 Budget, stating this is the same budget discussed in last month's Board meeting/Public Hearing. Mr. Deal noted the total budgeted revenues total \$34,825,654. The only change made was including the Medicaid's rate proposals into the budget. He emphasized a concern regarding two federal block grants, Federal Mental Health and Federal Substance Abuse, which might be merged into one grant by the Trump Administration and possibly reduced. So, we are watching for any developments there and will plan accordingly as any changes roll out. This includes any Federal changes to Medicaid that might impact Utah and the five-county area. Mr. Deal noted that he would review any potential impacts with the Board.

Mr. Deal then moved on to the operating expenditures, noting the total expenses comes to \$34,509,610. He then highlighted personnel expenses, stating the budget includes funds all current positions within the Center, a merit increase is available to certain career-service staff who are not under corrective action, and COLA for all Center staff.

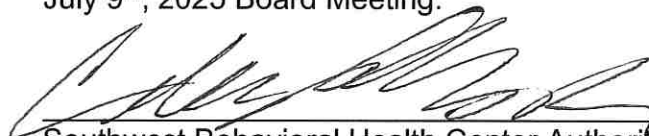
After reviewing several other areas, then finalizing the discussion on budget items and County match figures, Commissioner Meyeres asked for a motion to approve the FY2026 Budget and the Annual Financial Plan. Commissioner Hollingshead moved to approve the FY2026 Operating and Capital Budget along with the Financial Plan and Commissioner Almquist seconded the motion. The voting was unanimous in approval.

MEETING ADJOURNMENT

Commissioner Meyeres moved to adjourn the meeting and Commissioner Hollingshead seconded the motion. The voting was unanimously in favor of adjournment.
