



## Herriman City Safety Enforcement Area Minutes

The meeting was held on **Wednesday, June 25, 2025, at 6:30 p.m.** in the Herriman City Council Chambers, 5355 West Herriman Main Street, Herriman, Utah. ### **1. Call to Order (6:30 p.m. or as soon as possible thereafter)**

Chair Lorin Palmer called the meeting to order at 6:48 p.m.

### **2. Consent Agenda**

**2.1. Consideration of a policy outlining the process on how the Herriman City Safety Enforcement Area meeting minutes will be approved**

**3. Public Hearing**

**3.1. Public hearing and consideration of a Resolution amending the Herriman City Safety Enforcement Area budget for fiscal year 2026**

Finance Director Kyle Maurer explained that this amendment was necessary to account for two additional police officer positions that had been authorized by the Herman City Council previously. Since the City operates on a two-year budget cycle, the fiscal year 2025 budget had already been amended to include these new positions. However, the fiscal year 2026 budget, which had been adopted the previous year, did not reflect the hiring of these officers because the decision to add the positions had not yet been made at that time. To correct this, the proposed amendment transferred funds from the anticipated fund balance to cover the salaries for the two officers in FY 2026.

Trustee Hodges raised a question regarding the source of the funds. He asked whether the money was coming from restricted funds tied to a tax increase approved a few years ago. Director Maurer confirmed that this was correct, explaining that the funds were from a restricted allocation specifically designated by that tax measure, and that the allocation would support the full-time employee positions.

Chair Palmer opened the public hearing.

No public comments were offered.

*Trustee Ohrn moved to close the public hearing. Trustee Anderson seconded the motion and all voted aye.*

*Trustee Ohrn moved to approve Resolution R25-02 approving an amendment to the Fiscal Year 2026 Herriman City Safety Enforcement Area budget. Trustee Hodges seconded the*

*motion.*
