



MINUTES
WFRC || Transportation Coordinating Committee
April 24, 2025

WFRC Transportation Coordinating Committee Meeting was held at WFRC Office, 41 N Rio Grande Street, Salt Lake City and via Zoom.

1. Welcome & Consent Agenda [00:00:05]

Commissioner Jim Harvey, Vice Chair, called the meeting to order at 1:34pm and excused Chair Mayor Mark Shepherd. After welcoming committee members and guests, introductions were made around the table for those attending in person, and the names of those attending online were read.

Commissioner Harvey stated that the group would come back to agenda item 1a, approval of the minutes from the previous meeting.

a. ACTION: Minutes of the Trans Com Meeting held February 20, 2025 [00:06:58]

A motion was made by Mayor Rob Dahle, and seconded by Mayor Joe Smolka, that the minutes of the meeting be approved as presented. The affirmative motion was carried unanimously.

2. Chair Report [00:03:23]

Commissioner Harvey turned the time to Wayne Bennion, WFRC Short Range Planning Director, for an update on two federal items: 1) ozone compliance (air quality non-attainment regulations for Utah have been relaxed), and 2) the Safe Streets and Roads for All year 2025 funding applications are available for local governments. They are due by June 26, 2024.

3. Public Comment [00:07:45]

Commissioner Harvey opened the meeting for public comments. There were none.

4. Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) [00:08:12]

a. Report on Board Modifications to the 2025-2030 TIP

Commissioner Harvey introduced Ben Wuthrich, WFRC Transportation Improvement Program Coordinator, who reported that since the last meeting of Trans Com, WFRC received requests to modify the current 2025-2030 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). This modification was approved by the Regional Council at their March 27, 2025 meeting but did not require a new air quality conformity analysis or a 30-day public comment period. Mr. Wuthrich referred Committee members to the meeting materials for information regarding these modifications.

b. ACTION: Recommend 2026-2031 Congestion Mitigation/Air Quality (CMAQ) Program [00:37:30]

Mr. Wuthrich then reviewed the anticipated annual apportionments for the CMAQ program and the funding amounts available. He discussed the new CMAQ projects recommended in consultation with the Trans Com Technical Advisory Committees (TACs). There are two projects recommended for the Ogden/Layton Urban Area and four projects in the Salt Lake Urban Area.

c. ACTION: Recommend 2027 Carbon Reduction Program (CRP) [00:41:30]

Mr. Wuthrich then reviewed the anticipated annual apportionments for the CRP and the funding amounts available. He discussed the CRP projects recommended in consultation with the TACs. There are two projects recommended for the Ogden/Layton Urban Area and three projects in the Salt Lake Urban Area.

[00:45:54] Mayor Joe Smolka made a motion to recommend that the Regional Council approve the projects that have been discussed and reviewed for funding through the 2026-2031 Congestion Mitigation / Air Quality Program and the 2027 Carbon Reduction Program (CRP). Carlton Christensen, UTA Trustee, seconded the motion and the affirmative vote was unanimous.

d. ACTION: Recommend 2027 Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) [00:46:47] Mr. Wuthrich then reviewed the anticipated annual apportionments for the TAP and the funding amounts available. He discussed the new TAP projects recommended in consultation with the TACs. There are three projects recommended for the Ogden/Layton Urban Area and three projects in the Salt Lake Urban Area.

[00:53:18] Transportation Commissioner Kevin Van Tassel made a motion to recommend that the Regional Council approve the projects that have been discussed and reviewed for funding through the 2027 Transportation Alternatives Program. Mayor Joe Smolka seconded the motion, and the affirmative vote was unanimous.

e. ACTION: Recommend 2026-2031 Surface Transportation Program (STP) [00:53:47] Mr. Wuthrich continued his report by reviewing the process for developing project recommendations and illustrated the value of both the approved technical criteria and other relevant professional considerations in the project evaluation process. He then reviewed the anticipated annual apportionments for the STP and the funding amounts available. Mr. Wuthrich discussed the new STP projects recommended in consultation with the TACs. These included six projects to add to the STP in the Ogden/ Layton Urban Area and 10 projects to add in the Salt Lake Urban Area.

[01:03:06] Mayor Rob Dahle made a motion to recommend that the Regional Council approve the projects that were discussed and reviewed for funding through the 2026-2031 Surface Transportation Program. Carlton Christensen, UTA Trustee, seconded the motion, and the affirmative vote was unanimous.

5. Other Business and Adjournment [01:04:02]

As there were no other items of business brought forward, Commissioner Harvey noted that the next Trans Com meeting will be held on Thursday, June 19, 2025. He then entertained a motion to adjourn. The motion was made by Carlton Christensen, UTA Trustee, and seconded by Mayor Joe Smolka, and was unanimously approved. The meeting ended at 2:39pm.
