

Ballots sent by mail must be received by the Salt Lake County Clerk, 2001 S. State Street, S1- 200, Salt Lake City, UT 84190 no later than 8:00 P.M. on Election Day, and electronic ballots must be received no later than 8:00 pm (MT) on Tuesday, November 4th.
