## RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANTA CLARA SUPPORTING AMERICA250 UTAH AND RECOGNIZING AND APPROVING OF THE SANTA CLARA UTAH250 COMMUNITY COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, Governor Spencer J. Cox and the Utah State Legislature created the America250 Utah Commission (also known as America250 Utah);

WHEREAS, the mission of America 250 Utah is to commemorate and celebrate, reflect on our nation's past, build community, and look toward the future by educating, engaging, and uniting Utahns and visitors to our state;
