DISCUSSION ITEM(S)

1. Fire Training Hours and Requirements – Chief Boulden

Chief Boulden presented the Murray Fire Department training and requirements for all Firefighters in the department. He included the requirements for certification for the state, areas of training, tracking and the training levels.

Certification:

Utah State requires 36 hours of certified training per year for all firefighters. There are additional requirements for medical and other equipment and apparatus training

Areas of training:

Chief Boulden explained that Murray Fire Department has two areas of training, fire and medical. Each area requires a series of classes for certification every year. These areas include the follow areas: Structural Fire Response, EMS/Ambulance Service & Response, Ice Rescue, Swift Water Rescue, HAZMAT Operations, Wildland Firefighting, Emergency Management, and Fire Prevention.

Tracking System:

Murray Fire Department has a computer program designed to track the training hours of all firefighting personnel. The training includes both department training, state training and expert training available nationwide.

Training Levels:

Chief Boulden explained the importance of all firefighters receiving the opportunities for training in all areas. There are 4 levels of opportunities to assure that department leadership, medical and firefighters receive the training across all areas of the fire department.

Murray City Fire Department has focused their educational efforts to have highly trained firefighters, and paramedics. They encourage higher education as a department.
