Background:

USBE staff presented several potential courses of action related to ASPIRE at the May 2, 2025, Finance Committee meeting. The committee directed staff to bring information back to the June Finance Committee outlining costs associated with:

- Getting Aspire to appropriate levels to interface and interoperate with EdFi Standards, integrating with other vendors, updating antiquated features, building new features, new board rule and legislative requirements, and
- 2. Moving LEAs using ASPIRE to other vendors, and
- 3. Projected cost of maintaining:
 - a. ASPIRE
 - b. Other vendors

Program Overview

Aspire is the State of Utah's Student Information System (SIS). Local Education Agencies (LEAs) have the option to use Aspire as their SIS. The Utah State Board of Education (USBE) maintains a team of programmers and technical support staff to develop and maintain the Aspire application. Aspire uses a Schools Interoperability Framework (SIF) that serves as a "translator" for the data submitted to USBE by all LEAs to interface with the Utah eTranscript and Record Exchange (UTREx) data collection. Data submitted is used for federal, state, and local government reporting and for funding purposes.
