Background:

Staff is proposing changes to R277-606 for two reasons. The first is that the current timeline for Dropout Prevention and Recovery Program reporting does not align with other similar reporting timelines. The timeline changes proposed in this draft would put these reports on the same timeline and streamline the reporting burden for LEAs. The second is due to code changes made in HB 191, High School Credit Amendments, from the 2025 legislative session and to include new requirements related to LEAs using the packet method.

Staff will present R277-606, Dropout Prevention and Recovery Program, Draft 2, for consideration and approval.
