# How is time spent on the van determined?

**End of FY25 there were 97 routes.**

**Routes are currently defined by how much time the driver is in the vehicle.**

## **Total route times:**

Category A: 150-170 mins ~ 83 routes

Category B: 171-215 mins ~ 9 routes

Category C: 216-260 mins ~ 3 routes

Category D: 261-300 mins ~ 2 routes

Minutes are currently determined by our transportation vendor.

# How are routes determined?

- Routes are currently determined by the vendor by a manual process.
- Additions to the routes must be approved by an Associate Superintendent and the Business Office.
- Changes to the routes may be necessitated due to additional students joining a route, behavior concerns, conflicts or other issues related to the current route assignment.
- We are currently reviewing the best process to determine routes with the intention of assigning the routes to the vendor in the future.
