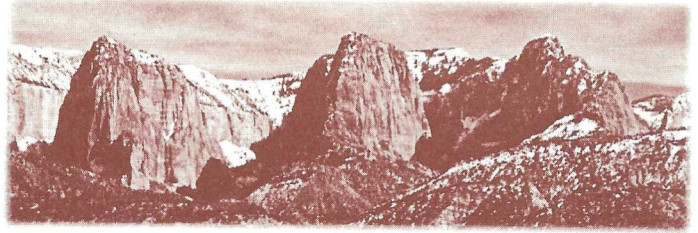

MINUTES Council Meeting July 2, 2025 7:30 p.m.

Pledge – Batty

Prayer -Debra Guy

Those in attendance: Mayor Prince, Councilmembers
Batty, Larsen, Pace, Allan.

Call to Order

1. Minutes read by clerk, Motion to accept with corrections made by Pace, 2nd Batty. Unanimous vote.
2. Gary Pfaffenberger – concerned about the right of way (Etherwood Lane) road to access to his property. He explained the problem. Thought it is a private road. Larsen – if it is a private road, thinks the owners should decide what they should do. Pfaffenberger wants to know if the town can back up the decision if the other two property owners vote one way and the other was opposed. It will be between the property owners.

3. Ordinance defining “resident”. Council discussed the time limit, driver’s license, etc. Motion to set up a public hearing for next month. 2nd by Pace, Unanimous vote.
4. Reports- Pace- cemetery problems with dry spots. The soil isn’t very porous. Becky Lloyd’s husband grave area has remained dry for over 4 years. Council will try to get it improved. Bushman headstone is out of alignment with the other headstones in that row. Pace will figure it out and get it moved. Larsen – got the invoice for the repairs to the roadways. Reset the water meter by the firehouse. Need to re-route the run-off from rain and snow. Council will take a look at it. Batty- The Consumer Confidence Report has been completed. Available to read and review at post office and town fire station. Mayor – wants the area by post office to make it look a little nicer. Debra Guy – wants to know if there are projects that the Relief Society to do around town. She suggested painting the fire hydrants around town. Fire Chief said it would be good as long as they use reflective paint. Forest personnel around town doing clean up around town.

Fire Chief – Fire crews here around town are trying to keep citizens informed. Community meeting at the Kolob Station July 3, 2025. A lot of communities in the area are having problems with insurance companies dropping them. New engine is here. Will be in parade on the 4th.

Motion to adjourn made by Batty, 2nd by Larsen.
