Eagle Mountain Municipal Code Amendments

- A proposal to amend Title 17.80.120 to establish a distinct set of regulations for Monument Signs on Commercial Properties Fronting SR-73. The amendment introduces detailed standards related to permitted materials, lighting, size, and layout—allowing only monument signs (not pole signs or billboards) constructed of durable materials like concrete or metal, featuring stacked panel layouts and internal LED lighting. It includes a tiered sign height and area chart based on lot size, defines spacing requirements between signs, and mandates coordination with UDOT for visibility compliance. Additional requirements include the use of approved schematic models, and limitations on business panel space. This section supersedes conflicting provisions in EMMC 17.80.070 and includes corresponding cross-references in Sections 17.80.130 and 17.80.180. *EMC Staff Point of Contact: Carlos Vasquez, cvasquez@eaglemountain.gov*
