

Fire Board

- The sales tax bill to benefit the EMS and fire departments in Washington county is still scheduled to be considered in the September legislative session.

Renewable Energy Report

- The PSC is expected to approve our program in January 2026.
- We have received 15 bid proposals from renewable energy developers responding to our solicitation. Our consultants are in the process of reviewing those bids to eventually create a short list of 6 bidders that we will submit to RMP.
- All the bidders are proposing commercial online dates from 2027 to 2030.

PUBLIC WORKS (Water, Sewer & Irrigation)

- Continued weekly testing of the finished drinking water for toxin found in the Virgin River.
- Continued daily operations at the water treatment plant.
- Working with Sunrise Engineering and Interstate Rock on the sewer lagoon improvements project.
- The Sewer effluent filter building construction is finished. Engineers are still working with Parkson to make the filters function properly to achieve compliant TSS numbers. Chemical injection pump station plans have been submitted to the State for approval.
- Interstate installed the Sewer inflow meter station. They are also working on completing items on the punch list that were identified for the entire improvements project.

STREETS

- Working with UDOT on the SR9 resurfacing project that is currently underway. Slurry seal is complete. Striping and crosswalks are being worked on.
- Sunrise and Landmark design and review of the Red Hawk road mitigation is complete.
- Plans are finished and ready for bid for the Church to Quail Ridge sidewalk project. Working with UDOT to get contingency money to help with the project.
