MINUTES WFRC || Active Transportation Committee June 10, 2025

WFRC Active Transportation Committee Meeting was held via Zoom.

1. Introductions and consent agenda [00:00:03]

At 9:17 AM Hugh Van Wagenen, Active Transportation Planner at the Wasatch Front Regional Council and staff lead for the Active Transportation Committee (ATC), welcomed members and guests to the meeting. He announced that Chair, Mayor Troy Walker was unable to attend, and Vice Chair, Mayor Joy Petro who was online, had to leave a bit early, resulting in Hugh chairing the meeting. Roll was taken for all attendees. **ACTION: [00:02:44]** Hugh Van Wagenen requested a motion to approve the minutes from the April 8, 2025, meeting. Mayor Petro of Layton City made the motion, and Mayor Dave Maughan of Syracuse seconded. With no further discussion, the motion passed unanimously.

2. Chair report [00:03:32]

- a. **New Jersey MATT** Hugh provided a brief overview of the 2025 Mobile Active Transportation Tour, which took place at the end of April in Hoboken and Jersey City, New Jersey. Mayor Ken Phippen of Farr West, Councilmember Ellen Birrell of Cottonwood Heights, and Jon Nichols, Engineer at Parametrix, each shared an overview of their experiences and key takeaways from the visit to New Jersey.
- b. **Mayor's Bike Ride, Golden Spoke Ride [00:25:13]** Soren Simonson from the Jordan River Commission provided a recap of the 8th Annual Golden Spoke Ride, which took place in May 2025.

3. Public comment [00:46:16]

Dave Iltis, Cycling Utah, made a public comment regarding SB195.

4. Layton Kay's Creek US-89 Project Ribbon Cutting [00:51:17]

Mayor Joy Petro of Layton City shared her experience with the Layton Kay's Creek US-89 Project, emphasizing its importance to the city and the significance of providing a crossing for active transportation users traveling across US-89.

5. Parks and Growth [00:55:22]

Mayor Dave Maughan of Syracuse City discussed the city's rapid growth and the challenges it presents for maintaining and expanding parks and open spaces. He highlighted the need for strategic planning to ensure that these spaces meet the demands of the growing population. Cameron Deihl, Executive Director at the Utah League of Cities and Towns (ULCT), then provided an overview of the resources and support available to cities for developing and enhancing parks and recreational areas.

6. Other Business and Adjournment [01:31:02]

Hugh Van Wagenen announced that the new Utah Bikeways Map is now available online. Mayor Dave Maughan made a motion to adjourn, which was seconded by Jared Bowling from UDOT. The meeting was adjourned at 10:50 AM.
