



2024-2025 Highlights

EVENTS

September 2024

- Author Event featuring local favorites Tyler Whitesides and Frank Cole. An estimated 650 attendees were able to meet the authors and participate in several activities related to the authors' books.
- Library employees and Friends represented the library at the Logan Pride Festival and the Logan Pumpkin Festival.

October 2024

- Library employees and their families, along with members of the Friends, participated in the USU Homecoming parade.
- Karen Clark retired after 27 years at Logan Library. She was the library director between 2017 and 2024.
- The library held a Halloween Carnival (attendance 400) in conjunction with Logan City Police Department's Trunk-or-Treat.
- Youth Services hosted a Film Festival during fall break, showing three movies in three days to 129 total viewers.

December 2024 / January 2025

- Library employees created a prize winning entry for the Downtown Alliance Parade of Gingerbread Homes.
- 3,239 visitors enjoyed an electric train display managed by the Friends of the Logan Library.
- Youth Services hosted a Film Festival during winter break, showing seven movies in seven days to 165 total viewers.

February 2025

- Youth Services visited Mount Logan Middle School to run an escape room that was enjoyed by 400 students.

March / April 2025

- Youth Services hosted a Film Festival during winter break, showing five movies in five days to 118 total viewers.
- The ability to place holds on items available in the library was re-instated.
- The Friends of the Logan Library hosted a film showing and panel discussion for the documentary "Banned Together".

May / June 2025

- Library employees and Friends represented the library at the annual Gardener's Market Children's Day.
- Youth Services held an Elephant & Piggie Party, attended by 81 people.
- The Friends of the Logan Library hosted local Magician Richard Hatch for an audience of about 220 attendees.

Michael Sauers was hired to be the new Logan Library Director, starting on March 24, 2025, and bringing nearly three decades of experience with him.










CARD HOLDERS BY AGE GROUP


