



My community service centers on using art as a tool for cultural empowerment. equity, and social change. In Fall 2024, I completed a fellowship with Voices for Utah Children, facilitating bilingual storytelling workshops and co-curating a community exhibition that uplifted the experiences of undocumented youth and immigrant families. As a current executive board member of Davis Dreamers, I helped organize DACA renewal clinics and college readiness events, blending advocacy with cultural programming. I currently volunteer with the Queer Spectra Arts Festival, supporting Spanish-language outreach, adjudication, and accessibility. I've served as an adjudicator for the Salt Lake Arts Festival and have exhibited with the Salt Lake Arts Council, Finch Lane Gallery, and The BLOCKS. These roles have deepened my understanding of public arts funding, equity in curation, and the need for inclusive platforms. As a teaching artist, I've led workshops with the Leonardo Museum, Huntsman Cancer Institute, Kimball Art Center, and Park City's Latino Arts Fest, focusing on healing, bilingual instruction, and intergenerational learning. I now serve as a Graduate Teaching Assistant at the University of Utah, where I mentor students and support arts access efforts

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
